Project Description

Queen City Art Racks is a new initiative to bring artist-designed functional bike racks to public spaces throughout Greater Cincinnati. The project was conceived in response to the demand for bike racks within the city. Queen City Art Racks is a green initiative that supports ArtWorks' mission of creating impactful public art projects and employing professional artists.

Budget

Each selected artist receives a stipend of \$3,500 to create a unique, functional bike rack. With this stipend, artists will be required to cover costs of design, fabrication, finishing and transportation of the completed rack to the installation site. ArtWorks is responsible for the costs of installation and plaques.

Apply

In order to be considered, artists must submit the following:

- Resume
- A minimum of 5 completed works from your portfolio (electronic files or hard copies)
- A short artist statement (200-500 words)
- 3 References with contact info
